
# **Unvaccinated International Travelers**

Here are the steps to follow when traveling back to Canada.

#### First step:


- Complete this <u>questionnaire</u> on the Canadian Government website before you travel. The questionnaire applies to both fully vaccinated and unvaccinated International Travelers.
- Upon completion, you will be informed on whether or not you can travel to Canada. A reminder that entry to Canada is determined by border agent. When the completing the above <u>questionnaire</u> please ensure that you select the answer that pertains to your situation.

For example, you are a foreign national & unvaccinated.




The next question will ask you "Which best describes you or your primary reason to entry into Canada?"


Here you will answer "under age 18 to study or visit family"



Next, you will be asked "Which best describes your travel plan?"
Here you will answer "travel to Canada to study as an international student"



You will receive the below result stating "You will likely be allowed to enter Canada".



Please note that once you arrive in Canada you would still need to adhere to the guidelines as indicated on the <u>Government website</u>, as you meet the requirements of an "*Unvaccinated International Traveler*",

You will need to ensure that you have a safe and secure location to complete your 14-Day Quarantine. If you **do not** have a Quarantine location, Student Services can advise you of the designated hotel for our International Students.

#### Second step:

## Fourth step:

• Submit your data via the ArriveCan App.

#### Fifth step:

• Upload Pre-Arrival PCR Test Results to the ArriveCan App.
